- I. Tony Greenwell presented a safety plan for safe sidewalk crossing, etc. Although there weren't enough people present to vote, everyone present did agree on the proposal and Tony Greenwell will submit it.
- II. Trust lands money spending and budget review
 - a. We voted on how to spend the extra \$10,000 from the trust lands money. It was discussed that the money can cover extra hours for Mr. Padilla and extra hours for Hailey and it can still cover the cost of 30 new Chromebooks for 4th grade. The council voted in favor for Mrs. Passey's spending plan on this point. We also discussed getting an extra cart and getting more Chromebooks for 3rd grade.
 - b. We reviewed the 2016-17 budget that will be turned into the state
- III. Community Council discussion/updates

- V. Data Gateway
 - a. We received an update on information regarding the State of UT data gateway program and the SAGE testing scores for our school and how they compare to the state and district
 - b. Discussion - the school administration continues in their efforts to generate student pride and in implementing strategies for achieving better attendance; things that will help the school's score in testing, etc.
